

OUR LADY OF THE RIDGE Reopening Plan

First and foremost, it is important to understand that our efforts will prioritize the safety and wellbeing of all while maintaining the respect and reverence for our sacraments and liturgical norms.

I have assembled a Parish Reopening Leadership Team (**PRLT**) to lead our efforts. Together we will attend required training from the Archdiocese to ensure our reopening plan conforms to the guidelines of the Archdiocese.

We will need volunteers to assist with various aspects of our parish reopening plan. Importantly, volunteers must NOT be part of the “vulnerable population”. I ask that all who are younger than 65 and healthy, with no underlying health conditions, consider assisting the one of three reopening teams:

- SET-UP TEAM
- GREETING TEAM
- CLEANING TEAM

The **PRLT** will make sure all volunteers are properly trained. Please send a message to goodnews@olor.church to indicate your willingness and ability to volunteer.

Following our training and certification approval at Our Lady of the Ridge, we will only open our church once our **PRLT** and I feel confident that we have the right volunteers in place to make it possible. Again, the need for parishioner assistance cannot be overstated.
